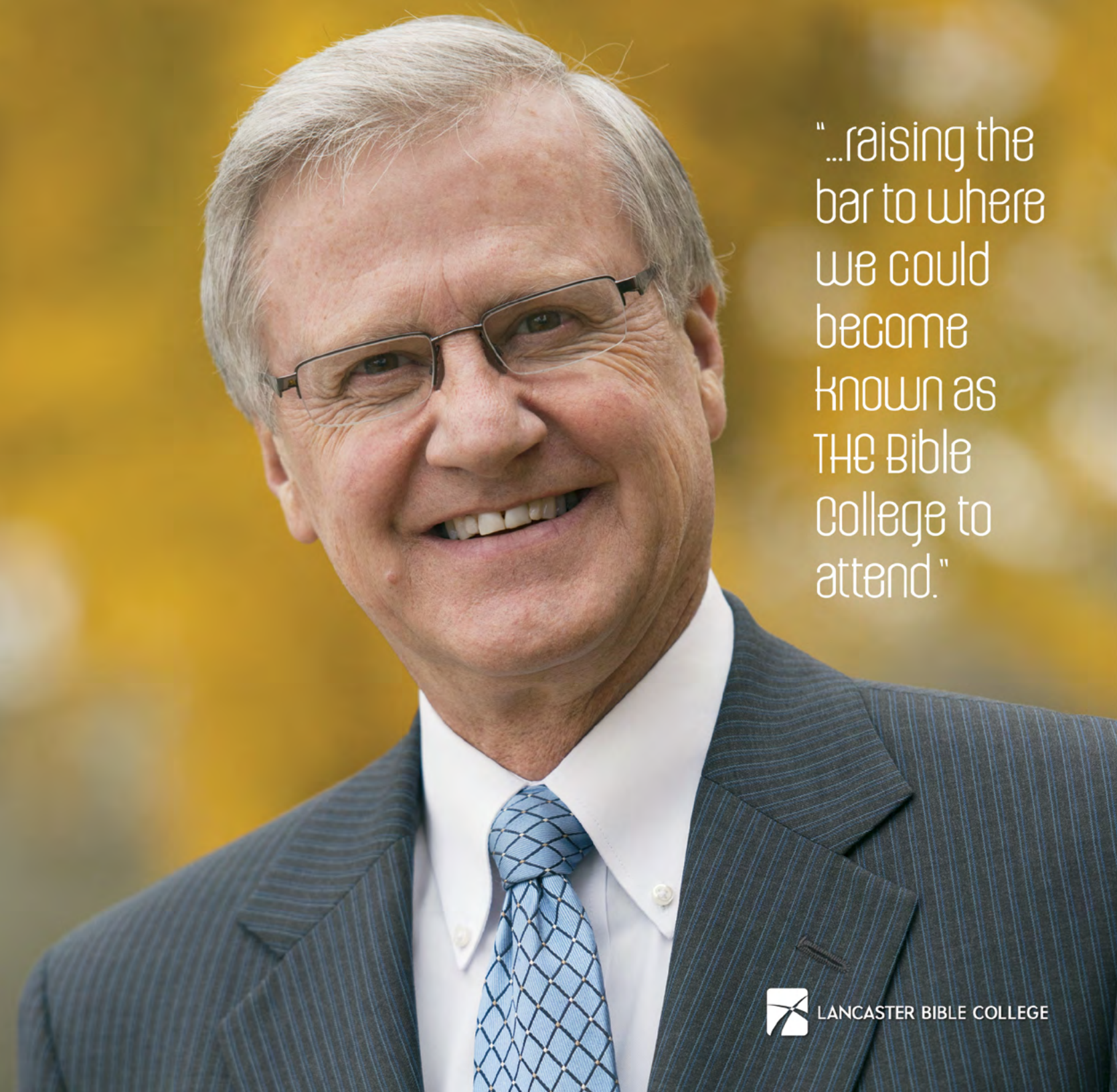

SCOTT FETTEROLF '96 HAD A RATHER LENGTHY JOURNEY THROUGH LBC. THAT JOURNEY STARTED IN 1983, INCLUDED A SEASON OF SABBATICAL FROM HIS EDUCATION, FOLLOWED BY A CHALLENGE TO FINISH BY A NOTED LBC FIGURE FROM THE COLLEGE'S HISTORY. A PATH THAT WAS HOPING FOR FOOTBALL AT PENN STATE WAS REDIRECTED DUE TO AN INJURY, THOUGH SOMEWHAT UNWILLINGLY, TO A PROFOUND CALLING.

"I ENDED UP AT LBC AS A 19 YEAR-OLD KID ANGRY ABOUT BEING THERE. MY WHOLE LIFE HAS CHANGED BECAUSE OF WHAT LBC HAS INVESTED IN ME. WE PLANTED A CHURCH THAT CONTINUES TODAY IN THE SELINGROVE AREA, A CHAPTER AS A MINISTRY EXECUTIVE WITH WYCLIFFE BIBLE TRANSLATORS, AND THEN A CHAPTER THAT JUST CONCLUDED WITH A CHURCH THAT GREW PRETTY RAPIDLY, AND NOW WITH LCBC CHURCH.

LBC TAUGHT ME TO THINK ABOUT MINISTRY IN A MUCH BROADER CONTEXT. IN MY CHURCH EXPERIENCE IN THE 70'S AND 80'S WE LEARNED HOW TO BEHAVE RATHER THAN HOW TO FALL IN LOVE WITH JESUS. WHEN I GOT TO LBC I REALIZED THAT WAS THINKING RELIGIOUSLY NOT BIBLICALLY. LBC HELPED ME TO LEARN TO THINK BIBLICALLY IN A MUCH BROADER PERSPECTIVE. YOU CAN'T GET MORE SIGNIFICANT THAN THAT."

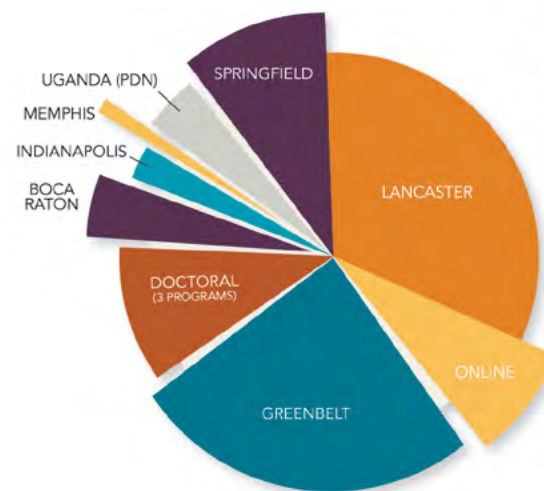
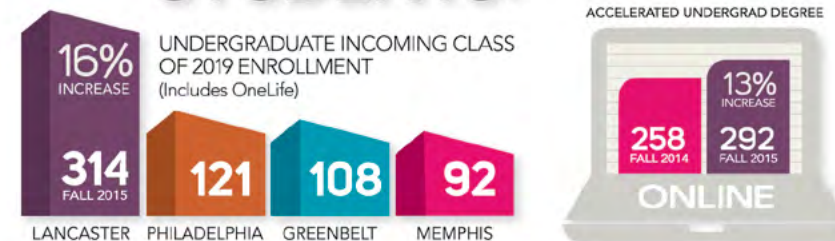
